Hajj Simulation Program (Foundation to Year 6) - Thursday 15th of July, 2021

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Assalamu'alaikum Warahmatullahi Wabarakatuh,

The annual Mt Hira College **Hajj Simulation Program** will run from **9:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. on Thursday the 15th of July, 2021** in the **College Gymnasium**.

Students from **Foundation to Year Six** will have an opportunity to experience the acts of worship required during Hajj. The students will also gain an understanding of the first revelation revealed to Prophet Muhammad (p.b.u.h) which is IQRA-READ.

For your child to take part in the full experience of this special event, they are requested to come to school in garments which represent the Hajj season otherwise known as "**ihram**". Girls are to wear a hijab and a long dress (any colour), while the boys are to wear white clothes simulating traditional ihram attire. Two white towels are acceptable for male students. Students are permitted to wear the clothing all day or change into their clothing for their designated class session if they prefer.

Parents are welcome to observe their child's experience. There will also be an interactive parent session hosted by selected Year Seven students commencing at 3:00 p.m. – 3:30 p.m. To experience the Hajj Simulation, we kindly request students and parents to wear a Hijab/scarf in the College Gymnasium.
