2022 Secondary Student Scholarship Information

Dear Parents/Carers and Students,

This letter is to provide important information about our 2022 Secondary Scholarship Examination. There are two categories of Scholarships offered by the College: Academic and Sports Scholarships.

To apply for a secondary scholarship for 2022, applicants are required to sit an examination which consists of two components: English and Mathematics. *This examination has been rescheduled and will now take place on Thursday 10th February 2022 commencing at 2:00 pm sharp in the College gymnasium.*

Criteria for an Academic Scholarship (Current Mt Hira College students)

Achievement of a total score of 90 or above out of 100 will qualify a student for full scholarship eligibility.

Achievement of a total score of 80 or above out of 100 will qualify a student for half scholarship eligibility.

→The Weighted Criteria for Achieving an Academic Scholarship are:

- Scholarship Examination (30%)
- Academic performance (over the previous 12 months or two semesters) (30%)
- College Values – Honesty, Fairness, Excellence, Responsibility and Respect (20%)
- Scholarship Interview (20%)

Criteria for a College Sports Scholarship (Current Mt Hira College students)

The following criteria will be considered when determining this scholarship:

- Competing and achieving success at the regional or state level or above
- Engagement in a competitive sports program operated by a professional provider/coach
- Participation in school athletics carnivals
- Participation in College Interschool sport events
- Demonstration of the highest levels of sportsmanship and effort in physical education classes

→The Weighted Criteria for Achieving a Sports Scholarship are:

- Sports participation and external achievement (30%)
- Scholarship Examination (20%)
- College Values – Honesty, Fairness, Excellence, Responsibility and Respect (20%)
- Scholarship Interview (20%)
- Academic performance (over the previous 12 months or two semesters) (10%)

Academic Scholarship Criteria for New 2022 Enrolments:

- Scholarship Examination (50%)
- Academic performance (over the previous 12 months or two semesters) (30%)
- Scholarship Interview (20%)

Sports Scholarship Criteria for New 2022 Enrolments:

- Scholarship Examination (30%)
- Sports participation and external achievement (30%)
- Scholarship Interview (20%)
- Academic performance (over the previous 12 months or two semesters) (20%)

Scholarship applications opened on Monday 12 July 2021. **Thank you to all of the students who have already registered.** We appreciate your patience with the delays to the 2022 Scholarship schedule.

Note - Current Mt Hira College students can only apply for a scholarship if they have achieved an average of 75% or above combined for all subjects and have consistently demonstrated our College values in the previous two semesters respectively. Students can meet with their respective Head of School to determine their eligibility for applying for a scholarship.

If a student earns a scholarship for Year 11 in 2022, they will maintain the scholarship for the entire VCE period (i.e. 2022 & 2023), provided that they achieve an average of 80% or above for all subjects combined in each semester (excluding withdrawn subjects), they uphold the College values consistently and they maintain a minimum 80% attendance rate.
