Important Information for Students' Return to School

As-Salaamu Alaykum

Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope this message finds you in the best of health and spirits.

Not long to go before the staggered return to school begins and we want to keep our students and staff as safe as possible. Next week, our Foundation, Year 1 and Year 2 students will be back on campus part-time. The following week our Years 3, 4, 7, 8, 9 and 11 students will also be back on campus part-time. All students will be back on campus from Friday 5 November full-time.

With the very high number of COVID cases in the community, **it is extremely important that if your child feels unwell or has any flu-like symptoms** (sore throat, fever, runny nose, cough, lethargy, etc.) **they do not come to school.** *Students exhibiting these symptoms will be sent home immediately.

Please also take note of the separate drop off and pick up points below:

- Parents/carers will not be able to enter the school grounds beyond the front office reception area. *Teachers and support staff will be available to usher younger students in Years F-1 to their classes.
- **Face masks** for students in **Year 3 and above are mandatory.**
- **Years 10 and 11 students** should enter the school grounds via the **Senior School Building.**
- **Years 6, 7, 8 and 9 students** should enter the school grounds via the front **Middle School pedestrian gate.**
- **Years 3, 4 and 5 students** should enter the school grounds via the **back gate** (entry via Greens Road), if possible.
- **Years F, 1 and 2 students** should enter the school grounds via the **front office.**

These are extremely challenging times, but by working together we can keep each other safe.
